# Chocolate Chip Cookies

Yields: 12 cookies

## Ingredients:

4 T butter  
 2 T shortening  
 ¼ C brown sugar  
 3 T sugar  
 1 large egg yolk  
 ¾ t vanilla  
 ½ C + 2 T flour  
 1/8 t salt  
 ¼ t baking soda  
 ¼ t baking powder  
 1/3 C semi-sweet chocolate chips

Read through the directions/ingredients and:

**CIRCLE** all of the equipment needed  
**UNDERLINE** all of the cooking techniques

## Instructions:

1. Preheat your oven to 375
2. Line a cookie sheet with parchment paper
3. In your Kitchen Aid mixing bowl, cream the butter, shortening and both sugars together; mix well
4. Add egg yolk and vanilla and mix until well combined
5. In a small bowl, whisk together remaining ingredients (MINUS chocolate chips)
6. Gradually add this mixture to your Kitchen Aid mixing bowl and mix to combine
  - a. DO NOT OVER MIX!
7. Using a wooden spoon or rubber scrapper, fold in chocolate chips
8. Cool mixture for 5 minutes
  - a. While cooling, begin to clean your kitchen and fill out your lab plans
9. Make 12 dough balls by rolling them in your hand and space them evenly on the cookie sheet
10. Bake for 10-12 minutes
11. Let cool and enjoy!
